Mentoring Program connects young Christian girls with spiritually sound Christian women who purpose to assist them with defining, outlining and achieving personal goals while seeking Godly wisdom in those efforts. With participating in fun activities and thought provoking conversation, mentors will promote and encourage positive choices with spiritually balanced and proper self-esteem.

All mentors must complete formal training with the R.O.S.E. faculty and undergo a criminal background check before they are allowed to interact with program participants.

About Us

R.O.S.E. Mentoring Program is a subsidiary ministry of PreacherWoman (Ask Seek Knock Ministries, Inc.). PreacherWoman is a ministry serving women in ministry and extend our reach by providing spiritual, academic, and social training and development to Christian pre-teen and teenage girls. The non-profit leadership development program serves girls currently enrolled in middle schools (6-8 grades) in the bi-state (Missouri and Illinois) areas.

The Executive Team of Ask Seek Knock Ministries, Inc. rests on the four pillars of the organizational goals for the R.O.S.E. Mentoring Program:

- 1) **Spirituality:** To promote and encourage Christian principles as biblically stated
- 2) **Service:** To model Christian service as demonstrated by Christ and women of the bible
- 3) **Scholarship:** To increase academic and career readiness for young Christian women
- 4) **Sisterhood:** To encourage comradery amongst young female Christians

R.O.S.E. Mentoring has crafted uniquely spiritual curriculum which focuses on assisting young Christian women to exhibit Godliness in the home, classroom, among their peers, in their community and their church by adding the components of peer responsibility and accountability.

Mission Statement

Our mission is to equip young Christian women to be respectable and respectful as they cement Christian disciplines, advance in personal development and civic responsibility.



Vision Statement

Our vision is to produce spiritually healthy young women capable of overcoming, excelling and advancing the Kingdom of God in their families, in education, in arts and entertainment, government, media, business, and religion.

Program Overview

R.O.S.E. Mentoring Program is designed for middle-school Christian girls. By offering them a safe place to gather and to share, the program is designed to meet the spiritual, emotional, physical and mental needs of growing Christian young women. The monthly two hour sessions feature a structured conversation and or activity led by one or more of the licensed and ordained female clergy members serving in leadership roles spiritually, academically, socially, personally and professionally (many of the leaders have earned graduate degrees in numerous disciplines). Topics include but are not limited to dating, career choices and options, health and fitness, nutrition, cooking, sports, entertainment, crafts, spiritual identity, financial empowerment, entrepreneurial opportunities, healthy relationships with parents, siblings, peers, etc.

The program also examine and address socio-economic issues such as poverty, teen pregnancy, substance abuse, education and health disparities and racism all from a biblical perspective. The program purposes to develop strong leadership skills and character traits such as integrity, honesty, respecting diverse opinions and beliefs, clear communication, analytical and critical thinking, and good decision making.

Although designed to work with young Christian girls in middle school, the program affords participants to have ongoing academic and relational support with mentors and possible guest speakers, while building lifelong friendships with fellow participants.

Our Monthly Sessions

The monthly two hour sessions will utilize group and individual mentoring techniques. Although the groups meet monthly, participants are required to be in contact with their group leader/mentor weekly. The activities range from workshops, seminars, focus groups to social and cultural field trips. The workshops focus on five main areas:

- 1) Personal development
- 2) Spiritual development
- 3) Family development
- 4) Church development
- 5) Civic development

Funding

If your daughter is chosen to participant in the program, an annual fee of \$150 is assessed to cover the cost of initial program supplies; t-shirt, bag, journal, and water bottle. Additional program costs will be assessed for occasional tickets, field trips, etc. Although we cannot guarantee scholarships, we do work tirelessly to acquire support from sponsors, grants, and other funding sources.
